



## NC PROFESSIONAL EDUCATORS LICENSE EXAM PREP WORKSHOPS (MATH AND GENERAL CURRICULUM SUBTEST)

The Piedmont Triad Education Consortium is partnering with NCMASST to offer two-day sessions to prepare beginning K-6 elementary teachers and K-12 special education general curriculum teachers who must pass the required Mathematics and/or Multi-Subject Subtests by June 30, 2018 in order to receive their NC Professional Educators License and be able to teach in the fall of 2018.

PTEC is opening these workshops to teachers in districts outside of its service area for a registration fee of \$175 for each two-day face-to-face session with virtual follow-up.
